Dear Berryessa Pines resident,

Your Napa County District 3 Supervisor, Diane Dillon, has asked us to inform you of our upcoming **TRI, GIRL, TRI TRIATHLON** scheduled for Saturday, October 9th. This will be our 7th year hosting the all-women's **TRI, GIRL, TRI** but the second year it will take place at Oak Shores.

We hope that over the years we've earned the reputation among the Lake Berryessa community as safe and responsible event producers, who are genuinely concerned about minimizing our events' impact on the surrounding community.

Throughout our 28-year history of event production, safety has been the cornerstone of Enviro-Sports events. Up to six hundred women will be participating this year to swim a half-mile in Lake Berryessa and to bike 11 miles and run 3 miles along Knoxville Road on Saturday, October 9th.

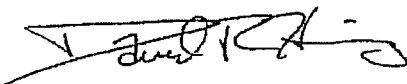
As a safety precaution, an 8-mile section of Knoxville Road (from Pope Canyon Rd. to the north end of Spanish Flat Loop Road) will be closed to **non-local** traffic from 9 to 12:00 noon (at the latest) on Saturday, October 9th. The Napa County Board of Supervisors has issued a permit for these road closures and the California Highway Patrol will be controlling traffic.

Some local traffic will be allowed on Knoxville Road during these times; however, the volume of cyclists and runners on the road during the events may necessitate holding traffic back for periods of time for the safety of participants.

If you must drive on Knoxville Road during these hours on October 9th, we ask that you do so with extra caution; as many as 600 cyclists and runners will be using this thoroughfare during these times. CHP will be controlling traffic, so please respect their authority.

We appreciate your cooperation with our effort to put on safe events. Your sharing the beautiful place you live with our participants is a gift we don't take for granted. We hope you'll join us as a spectator – or perhaps, one year as a participant – and witness the remarkable joy this event brings to our participants.
