Dear Berryessa Pines Resident,

Your Napa County District 3 Supervisor, Diane Dillon, has asked us to inform you of our upcoming **Napa Valley Triathlons** scheduled for Saturday, May 5th and Sunday, May 6th. This will be our 14th year hosting triathlons in the beautiful area you get to call home. Throughout our 30-year history of event production safety has been the cornerstone of Enviro-Sports' events. Three hundred athletes will join us on Saturday, May 5th for the 8th annual **Napa Vintage Half-Ironman Triathlon**, which includes a 1.2-mile swim, 56-mile bike and 13.1-mile run. Six hundred people have signed up this year for the 14th annual **Napa Valley Sprint Triathlon** on Sunday, May 6th. This event includes a half-mile swim in Lake Berryessa, an 11 mile bike ride and a 3 mile run along Knoxville Road. The start, finish and all transitions will take place for both events at Chaparral Cove. A full description of these events, including course maps are available online at www.envirosports.com.

As a safety precaution, an 8-mile section of Knoxville Road (from 4.7 mile north of Chaparral Cove to Pope Canyon Rd) will have intermittent traffic control from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 5th. **Local traffic will be allowed on Knoxville Road during these times; however, the volume of cyclists and runners on the road during the events may necessitate holding traffic back for periods of time for the safety of participants.**

This same section of road will be closed to **all** traffic from 8:00 a.m. to approximately 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 6th. The Napa County Board of Supervisors has issued a permit for these road closures and the California Highway Patrol will be controlling traffic on both dates. If you must drive on Knoxville Road during these hours on May 5th and May 6th, please be aware of these road closures and if you are escorted through, we ask that you do so with extra caution; as many as 600 cyclists and runners will be using this thoroughfare during these times. CHP will be controlling traffic, so please respect their authority.

We appreciate your cooperation with our effort to put on safe events. Your sharing the beautiful place you live with our participants is a gift we don't take for granted. We hope you'll join us as a spectator – or perhaps, one year as a participant – and witness the remarkable joy this event brings to our participants.
