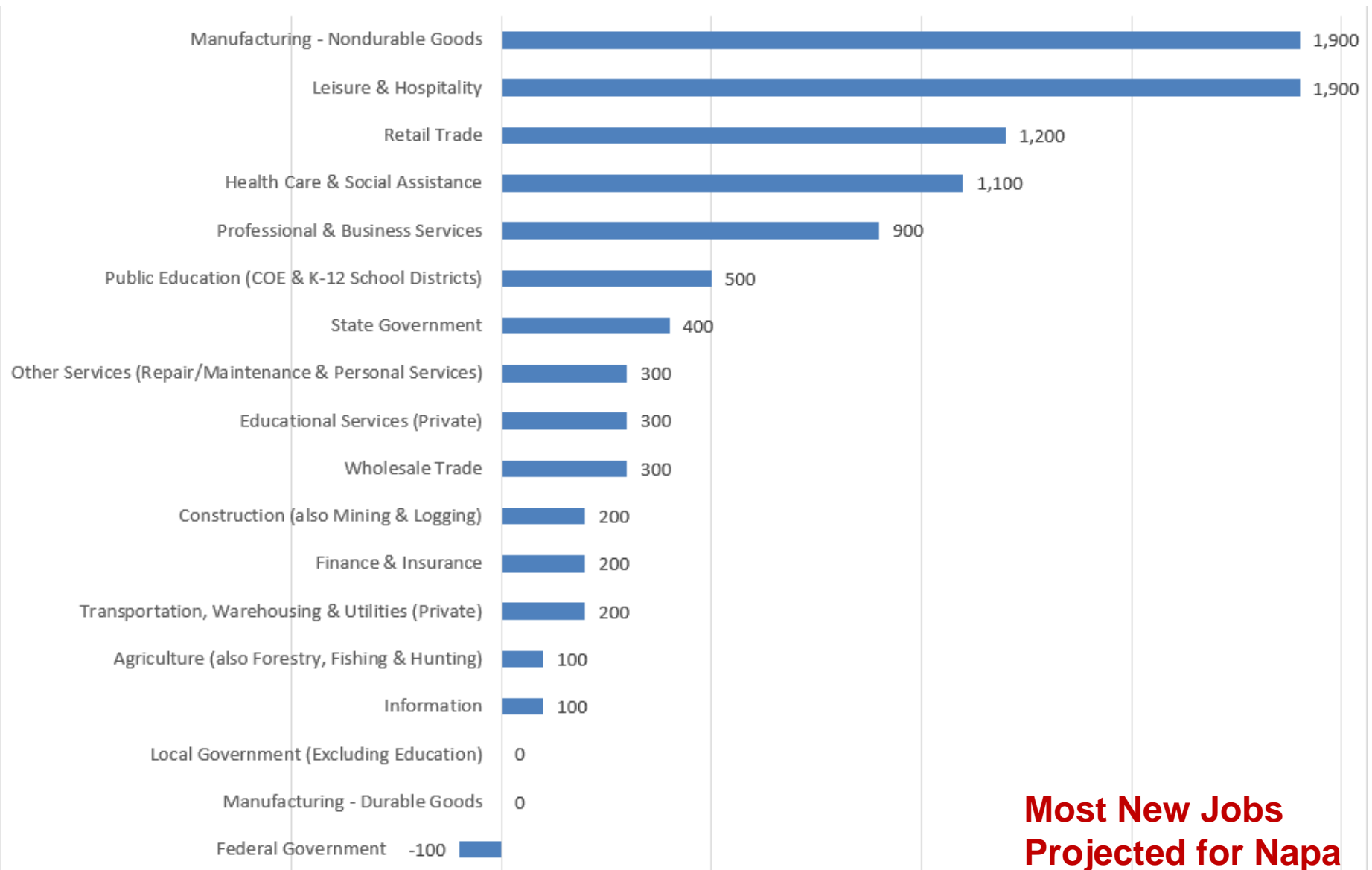




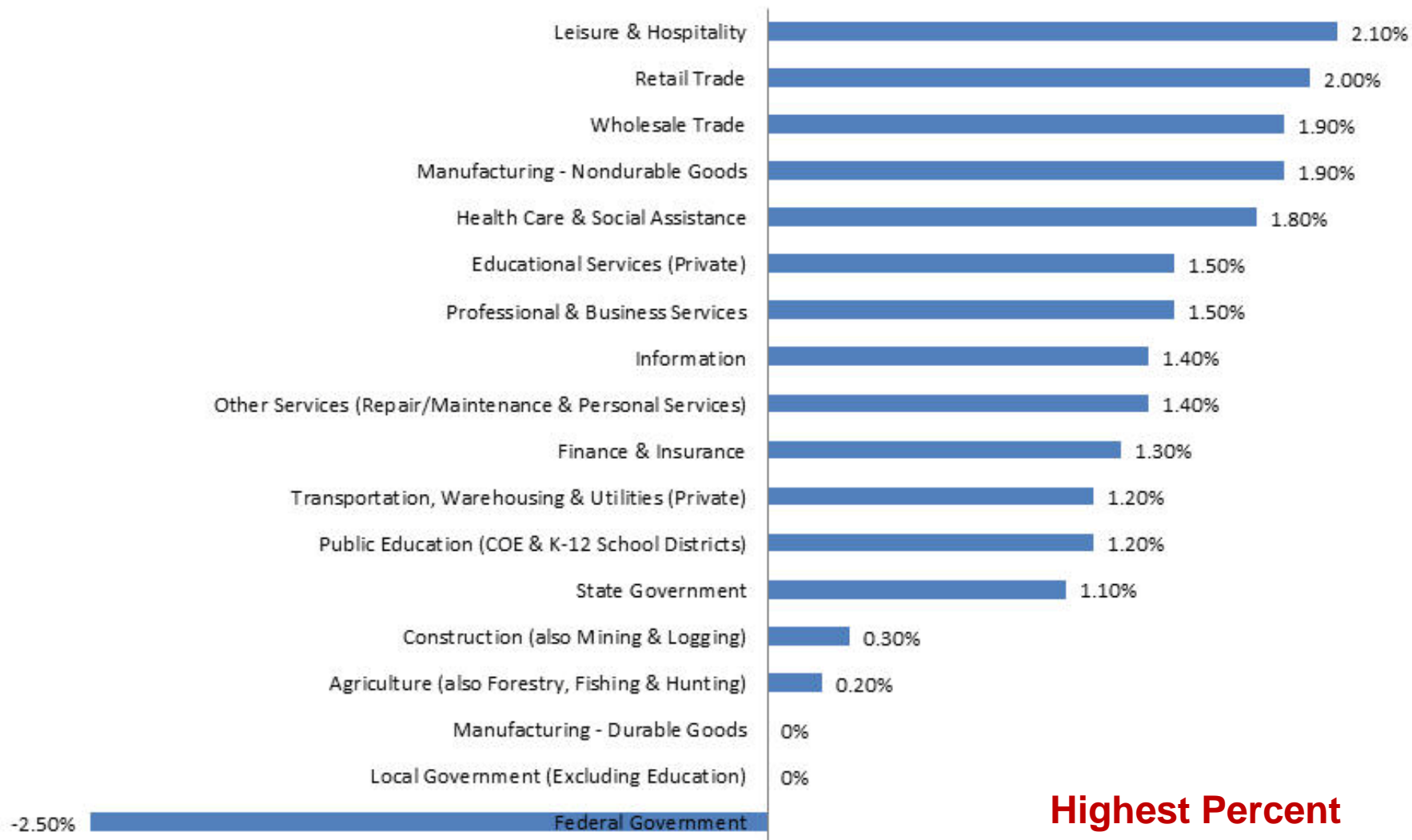

Employment Growth/Decline Over The Past 20 Years in Napa County

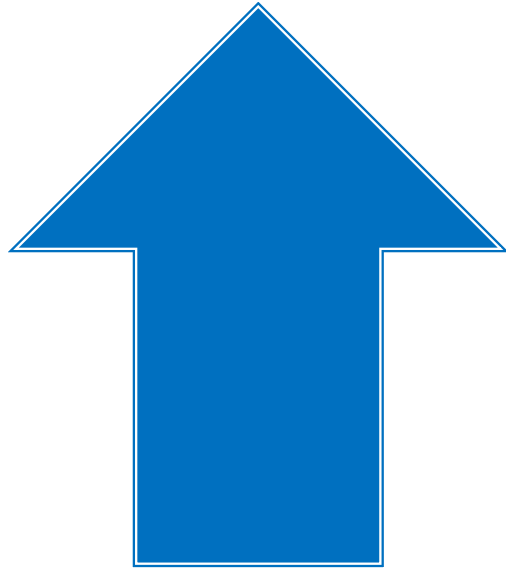




**Most New Jobs

County, 2008-2018**

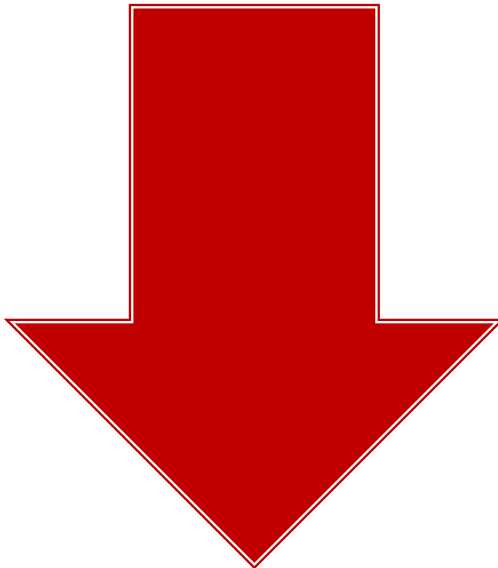


**Highest Percent

Middle skill occupations requiring at least 1 year of postsecondary education, training or experience

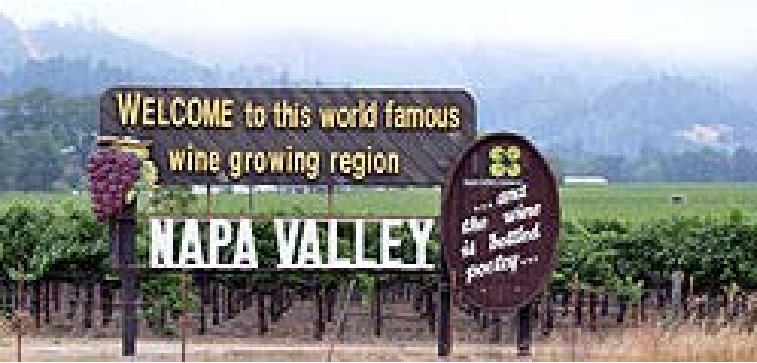


Slowest Growing Occupations:

5 Year Strategic Plan - GOALS:

1. Meet the needs of high demand sectors of the regional economy
2. Support system alignment, service integration and continuous improvement using data to support evidence-based policymaking
3. Increase the number of Napa & Lake residents, including underrepresented, who complete at least one year of postsecondary education with a marketable credential/degree, with a special emphasis on veterans & at-risk populations
4. Increase the number of high school students, including underrepresented, who graduate prepared for postsecondary education and/or a career

Three solutions “To meet the needs of high demand sectors of the regional economy” (Goal #1):

1. Establish industry-driven skill panels
2. Establish an education and training consortium
3. Establish a job skills assessment system supported by employers
