Richard Feldstein is the Napa County Superior Court Executive Officer. Prior to his appointment, Mr. Feldstein served as the Court Executive Officer in Tuolumne County and Assistant Court Executive Officer in Napa County.

Mr. Feldstein was also employed by the Riverside County Trial Courts from 1989 to 1998. During that time, he served as the trial courts' Personnel Officer, Administrative Services Manager, and Deputy Court Executive Officer.

Currently Mr. Feldstein is currently a member of state-wide committees and working groups addressing issues related to records management, web technologies, electronic filing, review of California Rules of Court, community corrections and the implementation of evidence based practices in criminal sentencing. In addition to serving as the chair of the Sustain Case Management User Group, he has also participated in past state-wide projects related to the Code of Ethics for California Court Employees, the Uniform Model Job Classification Manual, and the Trial Court Financial Policies and Procedures.

Before working in the state's trial courts, he worked as a management consultant with the Firm of Ralph Andersen & Associates in Sacramento. His responsibilities included managing large, complex consulting engagements in the areas of personnel and organizational management.

Mr. Feldstein has a Master of Arts degree in Industrial/Organizational Psychology from California State University, Sacramento and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History from Loyola University of Los Angeles.

On a personal note, Mr. Feldstein is married with three children, and has lived in the City of Napa since his employment began again with the court in February of 2009. He is an active member of the Kiwanis Club of Napa.
