NATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH WEEK, April 7–13, 2014

WHEREAS, the week of April 7 -13, 2014, is National Public Health Week and the local theme is “Health Starts Here”; and

WHEREAS, the Live Healthy Napa County 2013 Community Health Assessment identifies the top five causes of premature death in Napa County are heart disease, lung cancer, suicide, motor vehicle accidents and drug overdose, all of which have modifiable risk factors and may be prevented by making healthier choices or seeking appropriate health services; and

WHEREAS, Napa County Public Health with our community partners adopted the first Live Healthy Napa County Community Health Improvement Plan for 2014 to 2017, which outlines goals, strategies and activities to 1) improve health and wellness, 2) address the social determinants of health 3) create and strengthen sustainable partnerships for collective impact and 4) ensure access to high quality health services across the life course in Napa County; and

WHEREAS, Napa County Public Health, together with our partners, will work to make the healthy choice the easy choice in Napa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Napa County Board of Supervisors do hereby proclaim the week of April 7-13, 2014, as National Public Health Week in Napa County and call upon the people of our community to observe this week by helping our families, friends, neighbors, co-workers and leaders better understand the value of public health and adopt preventive lifestyle habits in light of this year's theme, “Health Starts Here.”
