- 3) Defendant shall correct or abate all the health and safety code violations on the Property by repair or removal so that they are in compliance with all applicable building codes and health and safety codes and if Defendants are not willing to do so, an abatement warrant allowing the County to pursue the removal of the health and safety code violations on the Property.
- 4) Defendant shall pay to County civil penalties in the amount of \$36,500, (of up to \$1,000 per day per violation) in accordance with Napa County Code Section 1.20.155, as stated in the Judicial Council (JC) form CIV-100.
- 5) Defendant shall pay to County attorneys' fees in accordance with the provisions of Napa County Code Section 1.20.025 in the amount of \$3,377.92, as stated in the JC form CIV-100.
- 6) Defendant shall pay to County abatement costs incurred by County staff relating to the abatement of the public nuisance in the amount of \$3,766.00, as stated in the JC form CIV-100.
- 7) Defendant shall pay to County the costs of suit incurred in this action in the amount of \$130.00, as state in the JC form CIV-100.
