#### Sec. 70.010. General.

The fees set forth in this Section shall be paid at the time of filing the application or other document for the permit or license indicated. No application shall be accepted for filing unless the fees are paid at the time of application. Fees are either (1) a one-time fixed payment, or (2) based on actual cost of staff time utilizing a standard hourly rate for the department which incorporates the overall cost of the County to provide this service (hourly fees). Any costs of legal review and consultation provided by the office of the County Counsel in connection with the processing of the application, including preparation of any related environmental documents will be charged to applicant. No part of any fee shall be refundable unless otherwise indicated. Unless specifically noted, governmental agencies and non-profit organizations are not exempt from these provisions. All such fees shall be paid to the Building Division of the Planning, Building and Environmental Services Department unless otherwise indicated. No part of any fee shall be refundable unless otherwise indicated. Unless specifically noted, governmental agencies and non-profit organizations are not exempt from these provisions. Additional fees associated with review and inspections may by collected by the Building Division pursuant to other sections of the Fee Policy Manual. Other fees established by statute shall also be collected by the Building Division as required.
