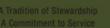

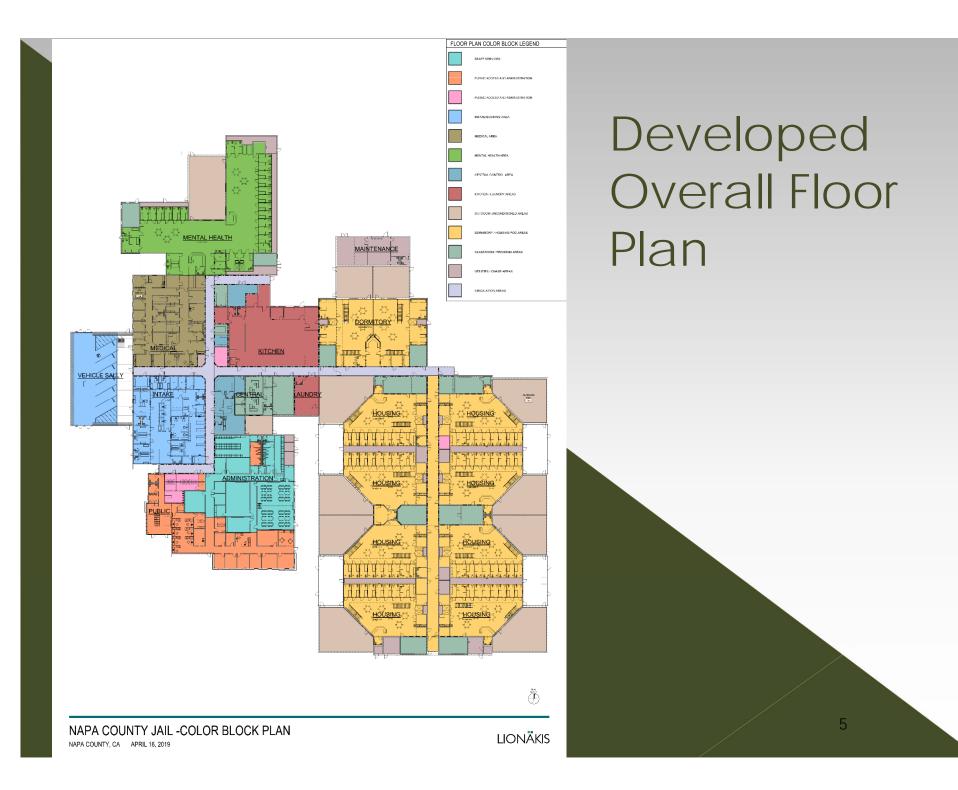

#### Schematic Design Cost Estimate

- Construction estimate \$8 Million above construction budget allocation
- Reasons:
  - Modifications including additional square footage for housing, kitchen, laundry spaces in transition from conceptual to schematic design phase necessitated by operational needs as deemed necessary by current Director of Corrections;
  - Significant increases in material costs due to tariffs;
  - ✓ Significant increases in labor costs;
  - As a result of schematic design geo-technical exploratory work, site development costs greater than anticipated
- Solution:
  - ✓ Value Engineering

- Schematic Design Cost Estimate (Value Engineering)
  - Precast cells in lieu of cmu
  - Maintenance in building vs. separate maintenance building
  - HVAC modifications
  - Site work reduction/modifications
  - Emergency generators (1 vs. 2)
  - Security system modifications
  - Building component modifications

Reduction in cost - \$6 Million; \$2 Million to be reduced during DD Phase

In addition, the Board has committed the Tobacco MSA fund balance to either reduce the amount of borrowing necessary or offset debt service payments needed through 2024.

- > Change Order Process During Construction
  - Need for change order is identified:
    - ✓ County
    - ✓ Contractor
  - If identified by contractor, project team (County PM, CM, Architect) review merit of change order
  - Change order may be rejected if identified by contractor and not agreed to by County; main reason for rejection is that scope is covered under original contract.
  - If agreement that scope is a change then change order is prepared.
  - Director of Public Works has delegation authority to execute change orders;
    - ✓ Contracts up to \$250,000
    - ✓ Contracts above \$250,000 10% up to \$250,000 and 5% above that amount;
    - ✓ Per Change Limit for contracts above \$250,000
    - ✓ Aggregate Change Limit

- 10% per change;

- \$210,000
- 25% of contract amount 15

- Change Order Process During Construction
  - Change orders greater than \$210,000 Board Approval
  - Change orders greater than \$50,000 CEO Approval
- Status of change orders to be provided to Board during these periodic public updates

- Continuation of the design development project phase
- Design development cost estimate
- RFQ CM services
- Ouarterly project updates through design
