


# GIS in PBES

# Geographic Information System



- Cartography (aka *mapmaking*)
- Combine physical **locations** (points, lines, polygons) with rich spreadsheet-like **data**
- Compare and analyze data and their locations

# ITS vs PBES

#### • ITS:

- Maintains county GIS infrastructure (databases/software)
- Provides technical support and programming expertise
- Maintains county base layers (parcels, roads, etc)

#### • PBES:


- 2-person team
- Manages > 100 of its own internal GIS layers
- Manages the GIS program within PBES to serve its 4 divisions

- Project review
- Documenting development (vineyards, ECPs, wineries)
- CEQA analysis on a project basis
- Research and analysis for policy development and long-range planning
- Cartography
- Desktop GIS vs. web-based GIS
