BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

County Executive Officer seeks discussion and direction on the FY17 Appropriations Bill and its potential impact on Napa County. The attached list includes those programs of interest to Napa County.

The House on Wednesday May 3, 2017, approved a bipartisan spending deal to keep the federal government funded through September 2017 and avoid a shutdown. The \$1.1 trillion bill passed with support from both parties in a 309-118 vote. Fifteen Democrats and 103 Republicans voted against it. It now heads to the Senate, which will have to approve it by Friday May 5, 2017, when current funding expires.
