SUBJECT: Approve Sewer Service Charge Refund - 1330 Brown Street

RECOMMENDATION

Approve refund of \$1,109.76 for FY 2016-17, \$965.00 for FY 2015-16, \$939.64 for FY 2014-15 and \$915.84 for FY 2013-14 (total of \$3,537.22) for sewer service charges for Assessor Parcel Number 003-136-008, located at 1330 Brown Street.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The owners of 1330 Brown Street have requested that their sewer service charges be adjusted for FY 2013-14 through 2016-17.

Owners purchased this property in April 2013 and have maintained the property as 2 single family dwellings since the purchase date. District records previously classified this parcel as a duplex and 3 apartments. Sewer service charges were calculated on the basis of 3.8 EDUs for this parcel.

After a physical inspection and review of Napa County records, staff agrees that the parcel should be classified as two single family dwellings with an EDU of 2.0. Staff recommends adjusting the second property tax installment for the FY 2016-17 charges and issuing a check refund for FY 2013-14 to 2015-16 as the property taxes have been paid in full for those years.

the sewer service charges is appropriate.
