SUBJECT: Approve Sewer Service Charge Refund to City of Napa

RECOMMENDATION

Approve refund of \$10,392.00 to City of Napa for FY 2015-16 sewer service charges for Assessor Parcel Number 050-330-005, located at 3201 - 3299 Laurel Street, Napa (Laurel Manor).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

City of Napa owns a 50 unit apartment complex on Laurel Street which is operated as low income housing for residents. City of Napa contracts Hedgerow Property Management to operate the complex.

For FY 2015-16 Hedgerow Management was invoiced for \$10,392.00 for sewer service charges for the facility and the invoice was paid in full. City of Napa was also inadvertently charged \$10,392.00 for the facility on their annual property tax bill for this parcel and the property taxes have been paid in full.

It has been the District's practice to bill Hedgerow Management for these annual sewer service charges. Staff believes the City of Napa should be refunded \$10,392.00 for the charges which were erroneously applied to their property tax statement.
