RECOMMENDATION

Approve the Project, concur with Staff's determination that the Project is categorically exempt, and authorize the General Manager to issue Notice Inviting Bids for the 2018 Treatment Plant Improvement Project (CIP 18736).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The scope of work for the 2018 Treatment Plant Improvement Project includes the following items:

- 1. 12kV project
- 2. 3W improvements and 3W VFD
- 3. Operations building HVAC
- 4. Primary influent pipe rehabilitation
- 5. Secondary pump station VFD
- 6. Pond 4 pump station leak repair
- 7. Operations building electrical improvements
- 8. Hypochlorite mix box repairs

The engineer's estimate of probable construction cost for the project is \$2,000,000.

Notice to Proceed is expected in April 2018 and construction is expected to be complete by the end of October 2018. NapaSan will hire a consultant to perform construction management and inspection services for this project.

Plans are available for review in the District's Administrative Office and will be available at the District Board

meeting on February 7, 2018.
