RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the attached Best Management Practices (BMPs) for Sand Oil Separators to serve as pollutant control mechanisms per the District's Code, Section 4.04.090.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As stated in Section 4.04.090 of the Napa Sanitation District Code, the District may develop Best Management Practices (BMPs) that serve as an enforceable control mechanism for prohibited wastes. The District intends to use these BMPs on certain classes of users. The practices listed in the attached documents are designated as "Required" or "Recommended." BMPs that are required will be enforced through inspections, while recommended BMPs are intended to be educational.
