## **RECOMMENDATION**

Approve the Project and concur with Staff's determination that the Project is Categorically Exempt for the 2017 SSMH Adjustment Project (CIP 13702).

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The 2017 SSMH Adjustment Project will adjust to grade up to 300 sanitary sewer manholes and up to 50 sanitary sewer flush holes associated with the City of Napa's annual paving projects. Due to the timing of paving NapaSan will divide the 2017 project up into two separate phases/contracts. It is expected that all the work will be completed by the end of this calendar year.

Staff has prepared a Notice of Exemption that covers the entire 2017 project. Staff will come back to the Board to award each phase separately.

Staff performed a preliminary CEQA review of this project and determined the project is Categorically Exempt. This
