RESOLUTION NO. 11-003

RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA SANITATION DISTRICT GRANTING RELIEF ON APPLICATION FOR MODIFICATION OF SECTION 906(E) OF ORDINANCE 87 AS APPLIED TO 201 AND 251 RIVERSIDE DRIVE (APN's: 005-123-006 & 005-123-011) IN NAPA

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors adopted Sewer Use Ordinance 87 on September 15, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Section 906(E) of the Ordinance states that capacity charge credits shall be valid for a period of two years from the date the demolition permit is issued by the District, and shall remain with the parcel from which they were established; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric ("PG&E") owns two properties at 201 and 251 Riverside Drive (APNs 005-123-006 and 005-123-011) (the "Properties"), and intends to conduct environmental remediation on the Properties for an unspecified amount of time; and

WHEREAS, PG&E wishes to sell the Properties to a developer for further development after receiving clearance from the Department of Toxic Substances that the environmental remediation is complete; and

WHEREAS, PG&E has applied for a modification of Ordinance 87, Section 906(E) so as to extend the capacity charge credit period for the Properties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Napa Sanitation District wishes to grant the requested modification and to extend the capacity charge credit period for the duration of the remediation plus two years, but not longer than five years from the date the demolition permit is issued.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors, as the governing body of the Napa Sanitation District, pursuant to Section 206 of Ordinance 87, hereby grants relief on application for a modification of Section 906(E) of Ordinance 87 as applied to the Properties and extends the capacity charge credit period for the duration of the remediation plus two years, but not longer than five years from the date the demolition permit is issued.
