Hi Nancy –

Thank you for talking with me on the phone about the sewer service charge rate for Oaktree Vineyard located at 2001 Salvador Avenue (APN 035-110-027). The property is charged sewer services charges equal to 1.0 sewer service units for each residential unit on the property according to Napa Sanitation District (NSD) Code Section 5.01.

Please find the attached letter, dated 1994, from NSD files that describes why the property is charged the rate of 1.0.

According to NSD Code Section 5.01, mobile homes are charged 0.6 sewer service units per space.

According to California Health and Safety Code, Section 18000 (<u>http://www.leginfo.ca.gov/cgi-bin/displaycode?section=hsc&group=17001-18000&file=18000-18014.5</u>), manufactured housing are not "mobilehomes".

If you disagree with the determination of NSD staff, as described above, you may file for Relief on Application described in NSD Code Section 4.01.050. If you wish to appeal to the Board of Directors, please provide written application, stating the special circumstances, citing the provision complained of, and requesting suspension or modification of that provision as applied to the premises. Upon receipt, we will schedule the hearing at a future NSD Board meeting (normally held on the first and third Wednesdays of every month).
