What are "Bubbled" toilets?

Happens during mainline cleaning

Forces water out of the toilet bowl

Vacuums water out of the toilet bowl



Why Does this happen?

High pressure used to clean main lines

Improper venting

Main line depth and size

Vicinity to home



Cost to the District

 Average 18 per year over the last 8 yrs (1 every 8 miles cleaned)

29 needing a cleaning service with an average cost of \$280.00

 Four resulted in claims totaling \$14,969.00



How do we prevent this?

Venting

Installing cleanouts

Adjust angle of our nozzle jets
