

Why is this project needed?

- 2007 Collection System Master Plan (CSMP)
 - Identified \$120 million in capacity expansion projects
 - Recommended an I&I Reduction Program as alternative to capacity expansion projects
- This project is part of the I&I Reduction Program
 - Brick manholes, clay pipe, and AC pipe installed in 1940s-1960s
- Complete in advance of City paving
