

From The Bay Bridge:

Take Interstate 80 to Highway 29. You have two really fun choices! You can either drive up Napa Valley on Highway 29 and drive through a few very quaint towns. Or, you can take Highway 29 to Trancas in Napa. Drive east to the Silverado Trail (this is the route that we like best, the views and the peacefulness). Turn left onto Silverado Trail drive up Valley 18 miles to Calistoga continue on Silverado Trail about 2 miles to Tubbs Lane. Turn left onto Tubbs Lane and look for a big yellow building and winery. You will see our gates on the right at 1171 Tubbs Lane.

From The San Francisco Golden Gate Bridge:

Take Highway 101 north approximately 55 miles to the River Road/Guerneville exit (north of Santa Rosa). After exiting, turn right onto Mark West Springs Road. Mark West Springs Road becomes Porter Creek Road after approximately 10 miles. Turn left onto Petrified Forest Rd. at 4.66 miles. Turn left onto Foothill Blvd/Highway 128. At about .8 miles turn right onto Tubbs Lane and look for a big yellow building and winery. You will see our gates on the left at 1171 Tubbs Lane.

Loud, rowdy crowd the day we went here. none of the wines we tasted were worth buying except for maybe the port that they poured at the end. I found the guys working the tasting room to be really pushy and focusing so much on how the wines paired with food that it made me think the wines weren't good enough to stand on their own. You shouldn't need to eat chocolate or eat tomatoes for a wine to be tasty and i felt like they were really pushing it. None of the wines tasted good enough for us to buy regardless of the food. This was the only winery on friday we visited that we didn't buy anything from. (granted this was a few years ago - summer 2011 - i just found some old review drafts that apparently I forgot to post!)

Cute property and it's sweet that you can see the mini "old faithful" from their windows. But that's not enough for me to want to visit again. They can't help the crowd that was there that day - you never know what you are going to get but it didn't help that their wine service guys were overly pushy. I felt like we were at a spring break bar and not a winery. I guess we're just not the right demographic anymore!





Decent wines (particularly the Charbono) and pretty grounds in the back where you can sit and relax. Staff wasn't overly friendly and we didn't learn much about the history, culture, owners, etc. of the winery. Not worth the stop in my opinion. Cool that they had a few bocce ball courts though.





Amazing geyser on property, friendly staff and a relaxed atmosphere. I loved the wine before visiting the room and when our pourer dug out a 2010 charbono for me it felt like Christmas.





Called 1 day ahead and was told they'd be open. When we arrived...there was a sign on the door saying otherwise.





This was the best tour we have had while on our honeymoon. The wine specialist, Jeff, took our palettes through 6 different wines that were all amazing. We went out to the vineyards with our wine, went through the back of winery to see the wine making process and were given two different types of Syrah to try straight out of the barrel. My favorite part!!!!

We bought a case and at the end Jeff surprised us and threw in a free bottle to take with us to share with our friends at dinner. We had a ball at this winery. Definitely a must seal!!!





What a great find! We were sent here from the tasting person at another winery as we were looking for a place to have our picnic. Summers is a smaller family owned winery with about 15K case production (so not super small). They have a lovely picnic area with a bocce court and a beautiful view of the mountains. The first winery we tried was by appointment only, so our next choice was Summers Estate. It's a cute little place with beautiful grounds. We headed to the tasting room & were the only patrons at first, but the place quickly filled with couples bearing passport booklets. Everyone was apparently there using some Groupon special that weekend.

Our pourers were knowledgeable & fairly generous with their pours. They told little stories with each tasting explaining the wines, the land, the vines, the winemaker, & the family business. It was pretty interesting stuff. I did feel bad that these folks had to tell & retell those stories all day long, tho. Every time a new couple walked in I'd hear the story again about the Charbono vines & the worker who serenades the vines with his guitar.

I ended up really liking all of their wines, but seeing that it's the holiday season, I was pretty much tapped out. I allowed myself 1 bottle of the 2007 Zinfandel (\$34). The Charbono & chardonnay were also excellent.

If I had a bit more in my bank account I would have gone for the tasting special...all 6 bottles of wine for \$180. Maybe next time.
