If you plan to rid your home of hazardous wastes as part of your spring cleaning, we have just the event for you! Upper Valley Waste Management Agency will host a one-day hazardous waste collection at the Upper Valley Composting and Recycling Facility located just south of the City of St. Helena and adjacent to Rutherford Grove Winery on Saturday, April 9th, from 9 am to 3 pm. A licensed hazardous waste handling company will accept a variety of hazardous wastes from local residents at no charge. Participants will enter the driveway at 1673 St. Helena Highway (Hwy 29).

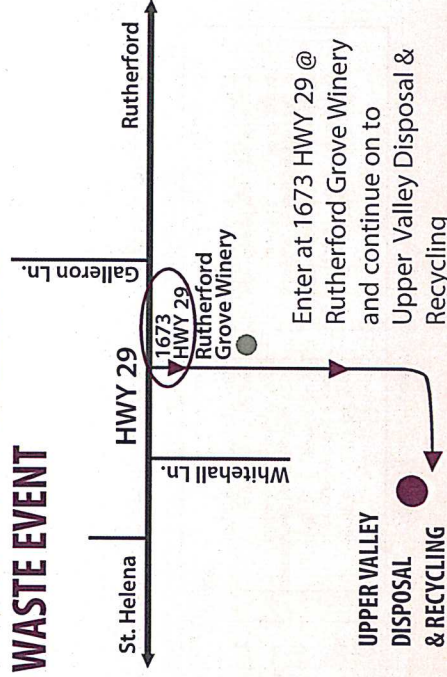

To be safe, residents should pack hazardous waste in the trunk or bed of their vehicle and transport it in amounts less than 15 gallons or 125 pounds per trip. The event is open to all who are UVDS residential customers or use Clover Flat Landfill, but the event is for households only.

Businesses that generate limited quantities of hazardous wastes will be able to dispose of them on Friday, April 8th, from 1- 4 pm. This collection event is open to only those businesses that generated less than 27 gallons or 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month. **Appointments are required – call 1-800-984-9661 by 5 pm on Wednesday, April 6** to schedule a drop-off time. Businesses must pay disposal fees for hazardous wastes that they

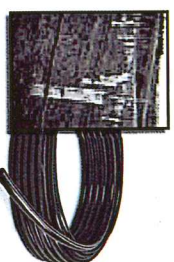
