

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING & COMPOSTING

As part of California's efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and reach a 75% recycling rate by 2020, recycling is mandatory for all businesses and apartment complexes.

Businesses that generate organic waste materials are required to separate the material for composting, the requirements phase in depending on the volume of waste generated each week.

HAZARDOUS WASTES such as fluorescent lamps/tubes, automotive fluids, pesticides and fertilizers, paint products, cleaners, batteries, etc. **cannot be placed** in the bins or carts.

Upper Valley Waste Management Agency sponsors twice yearly hazardous waste collection events. Typically events are held in April in St. Helena and in October in Calistoga. Businesses are charged a fee for this disposal service and appointments are required. To request information on these events email upvalleyrecycles@countyofnapa.org or call 259-8330. COLLECTION SERVICE

Business garbage rates are based on the size and frequency of service. Garbage collection is available in a variety of size containers – including carts

(35, 65, or 95 gallon), bins (1.5 to 6 yards), roll-off boxes (10 to 30 yards), and compactors. Please call for more information.

Up valley businesses also receive **free** recycling and yard trimmings collection along with their garbage service. Service is available in carts.

What Goes in Your Recycling Bin?

Paper



- Cardboard (must be broken down)
- Boxboard (e.g. shoe boxes, cereal boxes)
- Office paper (all colors)
- Magazines, catalogs & glossy paper
- Soft-cover books
- Envelopes (labels or windows OK)
- Newspaper
- Shredded paper in clear bags

Metal



- Aluminum cans
- Tin & steel cans
- Clean aluminum pans & foil
- Empty aerosol cans
- Loose lids from jars
- Small scrap metal
- Pots, pans & utensils

Glass



- Bottles & jars
- All colors, lids removed
- Rinsed & empty (labels okay)

Plastics Rinsed & Empty



- All CRV containers accepted
- All numbers accepted
- Bottles & jugs (all colors)
- Tubs & containers (e.g. margarine)
- Food service trays & deli containers
- Black irrigation hose
