After Christmas Special

On your first regularly schedule pick-up day after Christmas day, each household may leave up to four trash bags on the side of their carts. This is the only time the drivers will pickup additional bags left on the side of the carts. On other days, you must call and schedule a bulky waste pickup.

Two Free Bulky Waste Collection

Fairfield and Travis Air Force Base residents are entitled to two (2) free curbside bulky waste collections per year. Acceptable Items include approximately 3 cubic yards of solid waste or 2 large items such as sofas, furniture or household appliances.

- Loose items should be placed in trash bags up to fifteen (15) 30-gallon bags, boxes or bundles must be secured with twine.
- Refrigerators with freon and TV/CRTs have an additional charge (Freon Removal is \$14.28 per unit).

All bulky waste items need to be placed at the end of the resident's driveway by 6:00 a.m. Bulky waste pickups are typically scheduled Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Free Extra Garbage Pickup

Each household is entitled to one extra garbage collection pickup per year. You must use the garbage cart size assigned to the household.

Residential Curbside Recyclables

These materials are to be placed in cart with **BLUE** lid.

Paper Materials – Paper Should Be Clean

- Cardboard (corrugated)
- Chipboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes and other like containers)
- Computer paper
- Envelopes
- Forms (non-carbon)
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Office paper (white, colored)
- Paper bags (grocery, lunch)
- Phone books

Metal/Aluminum Materials

- Aluminum cans (soda or beer containers)
- Aluminum foil and disposable pans (disposable pie plates, lasagna pans, etc)
- Bi-metal containers (dog/cat food, vegetable cans)

Glass Materials – Clear, Brown or Green

- Beverage containers (beer, juice, soda, wine)
- Food containers (mayonnaise, pickle, sauces, etc.)

Plastic Materials – Plastic Containers to

- Clear containers (soda, water, and juice bottles)
- Color or non-clear containers (milk containers, detergent or bleach containers, orange juice containers, shampoo bottles)



Some Examples of Unacceptable Materials

- Carbon paper
- Ceramic goods
- Diapers
- Glass flower vases
- Packing paper
- Pizza boxes
- Plastic grocery bags
- Pots or pans
- Window glass

Please do **NOT** place recyclables in plastic bags.



Collect your plastic bags and recycle them at your grocery store and other retailers that accept plastic bags for recycling.

Green/Food Waste Material

These materials are to be placed in cart with **GREEN** lid.

Acceptable Materials

- Flowers
- Grass cuttings
- Leaves
- Small tree and brush trimmings
- Weeds
- Yard trimmings
- Bones
- Coffee grounds
- Egg shells
- Fish
- Grain products and baked goods
- Meat
- Other decomposable matter

Not Acceptable

- ⊗ Bamboo
- ⊗ Dead animals
- ⊗ Dirt, rock and sand
- ⊗ Lawn sod
- ⊗ Manure and pet waste
- ⊗ Palm
- ⊗ Plastic bags
- ⊗ Wood, coated or painted
- ⊗ Wood from construction projects



Please be careful not to contaminate the green waste cart with unacceptable material.



Plastic bags cannot be composted.

Collect your plastic bags and recycle them at your grocery store and other retailers that accept plastic bags for recycling.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) NEW SERVICE!

Waste Management's "At Your Door Special CollectionSM" provides appointment-based collection of household hazardous waste (HHW). HHW is any product labeled toxic, poisonous, corrosive, flammable, combustible or irritant. HHW items include paint, batteries, oil, and pesticides. Residents are eligible for two (2) appointments per year. Visit www.wmratyourdoor.com or call (800) 449-7587 to schedule an appointment.



HHW is also accepted free of charge every Friday and Saturday at the Yolo County Central Landfill. Visit www.yolocounty.org or call (916) 617-4656 for more information.

MEDICINE DISPOSAL NEW SERVICE!

Residents may dispose of non-controlled, over-the-counter and prescription medicine at drop-box locations throughout the City. To find locations visit sacramentovalley.wm.com or call customer service at (866) 844-1508.



FREE BULKY WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE NEW SERVICE!

Residents are eligible for two (2) bulky waste collection appointments per year (July - June). Eligible items include furniture, mattresses/box springs, electronics, tires (limit 4), small and large appliances, rugs, etc. Limits apply. Call (866) 844-1508 for more information and to schedule an appointment.



CURBSIDE USED OIL AND OIL FILTERS COLLECTION

Waste Management will provide used oil containers and filter bags. Residents may recycle up to two (2) gallons of used oil each month using this service. Used oil must be poured into provided used oil containers. Call (866) 844-1508 to request a container and filter bag.



FREE BAGGED LEAF WASTE

During the fall leaf season (November 1st – January 31st), bagged leaves may be placed beside the Organics Cart for collection. Individual bags may not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds.

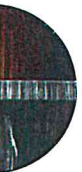


BUNDLED GREEN WASTE (ORGANICS)

Branches and prunings no larger than three (3) feet long and no wider than two (2) inches in diameter may be tied in bundles and placed beside the Organics Cart for collection. Individual bundles may not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds.

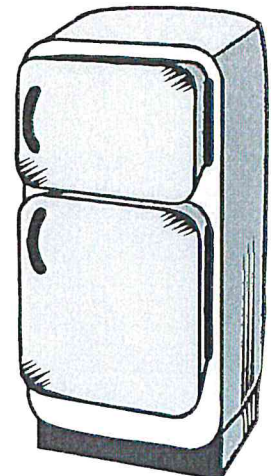
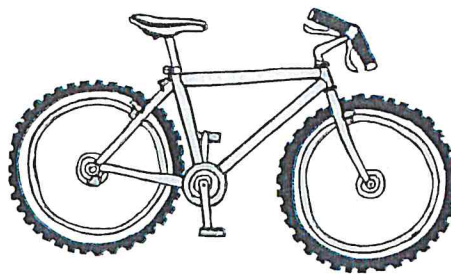
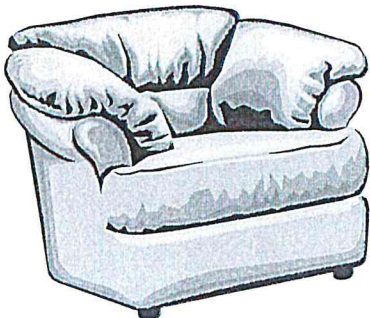
