- Lower Lateral = NapaSan

#### **Private Sewer Pumps**

- Discouraged
- Only in unusual circumstances
- GM approval





- Current language written for commercial & industrial users
- Residential not clear





Right to enter immediately if no reasonable expectation of privacy.



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Right to enter if necessary to access facilities for cleaning, maintenance, inspection, etc. – with proper credentials

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If prior consent sought and access is refused, may request inspection warrant (CA Code of Civil Procedure)



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If not accessible, District is not liable for damages

Example: cleanout behind locked gate
