HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENT

Saturday, April 10, 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Upper Valley Disposal & Recycling St. Helena Location

The Upper Valley Waste Management Agency will host a one-day hazardous waste collection at the Upper Valley Composting and Recycling Facility located just south of the City of St. Helena and adjacent to Pestoni Family Winery on Saturday, April 10, from 8 am to 1 pm. A licensed hazardous waste handling company will accept a variety of hazardous wastes from local residents at no charge. Participants will enter the driveway at 1673 St. Helena Highway (Hwy 29).

Appointments are required! Appointments must be scheduled by 5:00pm on Friday, April 9. Visit www.countyofnapa.org/hazwaste to schedule an appointment. If you do not have access to the internet, you may call 707-259-8330 to request an appointment.

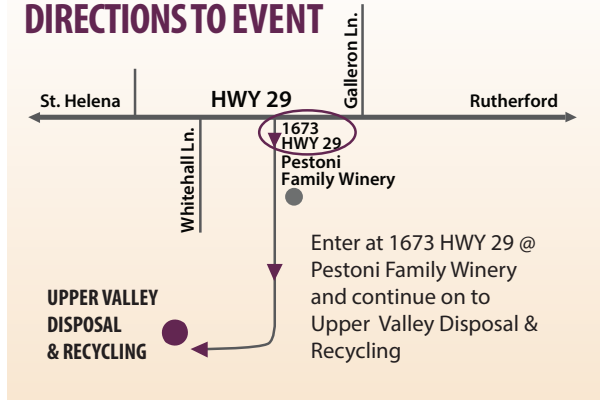
To be safe, residents should pack hazardous waste in the trunk or bed of their vehicle and transport it in amounts less than 15 gallons or 125 pounds per trip. The event is open to all who are

UVDS residential customers or use Clover Flat Landfill, but the event is for households only.

Businesses that generate limited quantities of hazardous wastes will be able to dispose of them on Friday, April 9, from 1 pm to 4 pm. This collection event is open to only those businesses that generate less than 27 gallons or 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month. Appointments are required – call 707-259-8330 by 5 pm on Wednesday, April 7 to schedule a drop-off time. Businesses must pay disposal fees for hazardous wastes that they bring to this collection event.

TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS:

Do not transport over 15 gallons or 125 pounds at one time. Containers used for transport must be no larger than a 5-gallon bucket.

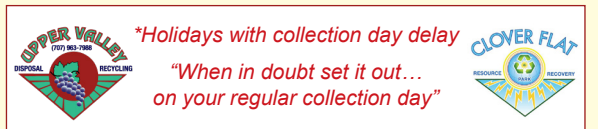

Triple Rinse & Dry

Cut Down Larger Containers

- 5 Gallon: Cut in Half
- 15 Gallon: Cut in Thirds
- 30 Gallon: Cut in Thirds
- 50 Gallon Cut in Fourths

Remove

- Labels • Metal Handles
- Caps • Plastic Sleeves

Break down all cardboard boxes **before** arriving at the event
