Include the Food!

You can now put food scraps, food-soiled paper products, and yard waste in your compost cart! When compostable materials end up in landfills, they generate methane, a powerful greenhouse gas. UVD&R's compost facility instead turns this valuable material into organic compost. When compost is used in landscape and agriculture it builds soil nutrients, conserves water, and reduces the need for fertilizers.

All residents are eligible to receive a free compost pail (see photo below). The pail will include a brochure with more detail on the program and sample compostable bags. The pails will be delivered to most homes and pick up options will be available throughout the community as well. Thank you for working with us to fight climate change through our compost process.

Recycling correctly has never been more important. Stricter state laws and more restrictions on what can be truly recycled. This means all recyclable materials should be empty, clean, and dry before they are placed in your blue cart.

Below are the general categories for recyclable items:

- Rigid plastics
- Metal (for example, tin and aluminum cans)
- Glass bottles and jars
- Clean paper and flattened cardboard.
