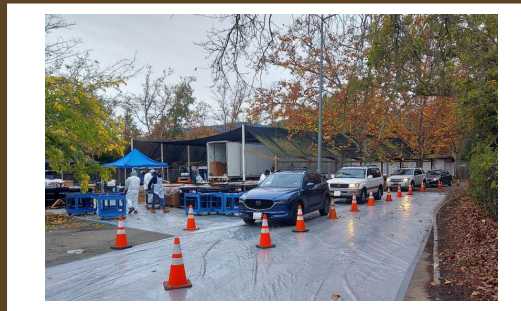


Include the Food!

- Put all food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings in your green compost cart at home
- Empty your kitchen pail often to reduce odors
- Store your kitchen pail in a cool, dry place
- Mix yard waste and food-soiled paper in with food scraps to reduce pests and odors
- Do not set your kitchen pail at the curb

Holiday Waste Tips

There are many ways to reduce waste this holiday season. See some examples below:

- PLAIN wrapping paper that isn't shiny or plastic-lined and doesn't have texture or glitter can be recycled in the blue cart
- Gift bags and cardboard boxes can be reused or recycled
- Tissue paper can be composted
- Old clothes can be donated
- ALL of your holiday food can be donated or composted
- Broken Christmas lights can be picked up as E-Waste in your bulky item collection or be brought to Clover Flat Landfill for free
- Christmas trees can be composted and properly handled in many ways (see the "Listen to Santa!" segment)
- Rigid plastics can be recycled in your blue cart

Here are a few easy ways you can properly compost your Christmas Tree:



- Cut your tree into pieces no larger than 3 feet long and put them in your green compost cart (no flocked trees). Please make sure your carts aren't overflowing.
- Bring your tree to Clover Flat Resource Recovery Park on Silverado Trail for free until January 22nd (does not include flocked trees).
- Live in St. Helena or Calistoga? Support the Boy Scouts!
 - Troop 18 will be picking up trees within Calistoga city limits on January 8th. Remove ornaments, lights and stand. No flocked trees or garlands.

All trees should be out at the curb by 9am to ensure pick up. Donations can be left on the front door or mailed to: BSA Troop 18, 2004 High Rocks Dr, Calistoga CA 94515. For more information contact:

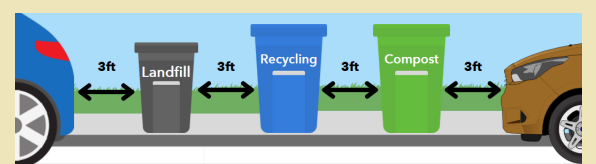
