Dear Napa Valley Resident,


Like the swallows of Capistrano, the inline skaters are returning to the Silverado Trail in the Napa Valley this August where they will put those powerful legs to the test in the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Napa Valley Inline Marathon and Half Marathon. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the event and make you aware of the temporary closure of a 7 mile portion of the northern end of the Silverado Trail.

The Napa Valley Inline Marathon will take place on Sunday, Aug. 7, 2005 starting at 7:00 A.M. Staging will take place in the parking lot of the Silver Rose Winery. A 7 mile portion of the Silverado Trail from Silver Rose Winery at Rosedale Ave in Calistoga to Glass Mountain Road will be closed to traffic from 7:00 AM. to 10:00 AM for the event. From Calistoga, skaters will roll southbound along the Silverado Trail, make a 180 degree turn near Glass Mountain Road and skate northbound along the Silverado Trail back to the Silver Rose Winery in Calistoga. 1 lap is 13.1 miles. 2 laps are 26.2 miles.

We want to have a little negative impact on your quality of life as possible. There will be CHP officers and cars at every intersection during the road closure. Please let us know if there are any problems or suggestions on how we can make this better for you.

This is not just an inline race, this is good, healthy fun!!! The racers get the glory, but this event is all skaters of all ages. The Napa Valley Inline Marathon demonstrates a new twist in the world of alternative transportation. See how this event has evolved over 11 years.
