Dear Napa Valley / Silverado Trail Resident,

Once again on Sunday, July 12, 2015, roller skaters will be returning to the Silverado Trail where they will put those powerful legs to the test in the Annual Napa Valley Roadskate Marathon and Half Marathon. This event will mark 22 years since the first time skaters began showing up to skate the Silverado. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the event and make you aware of the temporary road closure of a 7 mile portion of the southern end of the Silverado Trail.

The event will take place on Sunday, July 12, 2015. A 7 mile portion of the Silverado Trail from Oak Knoll Avenue to Oakville Cross Road will be closed to traffic from 7:00 AM. to 10:00 AM for the event. The start/finish line will be located at the intersection on Yountville Cross Road and the Silverado Trail.

We want to have as little negative impact on your quality of life as possible. We will not be using amplified sound to start the event. There will be CHP officers and cars at each and every intersection during the road closure. Our event will be finished by 10:00 A.M. so not to interfere with your visitors, workers and customers. Although the roadway will be closed to traffic, the CHP officers will allow your workers and families to get where they need to be. All they need do is speak to the officer as they arrive at the road closure area.

This is not just an inline race. This is good, healthy fun!!! The event is for all skaters of all ages. Please come participate. The road will be closed to cars for three hours and there will be plenty of room for you to enjoy our version of "recreational asphalt".
