Re: Reverie Wine Cave/State of California Compliance

Dear Mr. Gilbreth:

At your request, I am writing to you to confirm information that I provided to you regarding the Reverie Vineyard Wine Cave in Napa County.

Our records confirm that the only Classifications and Permits required from the State of California were obtained and I personally inspected the cave during construction in 2008. The State of California does not regulate the size of wine caves.

Specifically our records confirm that there were two Underground Classifications and two Permits to Use Diesel Engines Underground as follows:

In 2001 an Underground Classification as a wine cave was issued on August 9, 2001 and a Permit to Use Diesel Engines Underground was issued on August 16, 2001 and subsequently in 2008 an Underground Classification as a wine cave was issued on June 16, 2008 and a Permit to Use Diesel Engines Underground was issued on June 17, 2008.
