In my 46 year career as a registered nurse/family nurse practitioner, I worked 2 years in hospital nursing then 2 years in public health. After graduating from UC Davis I worked as a Family Nurse Practitioner in a variety of settings. My responsibilities were to provide primary care to all ages including senior citizens. I worked for the Department of State Foreign Service for twenty years living and working overseas and providing care for American Embassy employees and their families. I provided occupational health as well as primary care to National employees. I retired in late 1999 and moved to Napa County. I worked for about a year at COPE as a public health nurse and then was employed by Community Health Clinic Ole (Ole Health) for the next 13 years. I retired December 2014. Since retirement I have gone on a medical mission to the Dominican Republic with Somos Amigos and volunteered for one shift thru Ole Health at the Calistoga Fairgrounds shelter after the Valley Fire.

University of California Master Gardener of Napa County since 2000. I have volunteered over 1000 hours. Current co-chair of the compost committee and member of Latino Outreach Committee.

Napa Valley CanDO since 2009. Active participant in various volunteer programs. Current participation in CanDo CanGrow a program designed to provide vegetables for the Food Bank. Member of CanDo Waterway Keepers which picks up trash along the Napa River on a monthly basis and also collaborates with other organizations to educate and keep the waterways clean.
