RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY of NAPA, STATE of CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Edward H. Wynn was raised in this beautiful valley, graduated from Napa High School in 1967, and served with distinction in the U.S. Marines from 1967 to 1969, receiving three Purple Hearts, the Bronze Star, the Navy Achievement Medal, and the Navy Cross for heroism in combat in Viet Nam; and

WHEREAS, Ed began his career with the County of Napa as a Deputy Sheriff on September 1, 1970 under Sheriff Earl Randol, and distinguished himself as a patrol deputy, head of the jail, and head of the SWAT team, reaching the rank of corporal; and

WHEREAS, Ed received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Golden Gate University in 1977; and

WHEREAS, Ed was hired as an investigator in the Napa County District Attorney's Office in August, 1985 by District Attorney Jerry Mautner; was promoted to Chief Investigator on July 21, 1995 by District Attorney Anthony Perez; and currently supervises ten investigators under District Attorney Gary Lieberstein; and

WHEREAS, Ed is known among friends and co-workers for his patriotism, his integrity, his loyalty, and his dedication to truth, justice, and doing the right thing; and

WHEREAS, Ed's loyalty, personal integrity, and professionalism is greatly appreciated by his fellow workers and by the public; and

WHEREAS, at the time of his retirement Ed has served the victims of crime in Napa County and the State of California for thirty-five years with distinction and perseverance to insure that they receive justice; and

WHEREAS, Ed has constantly demonstrated the ability to carry out the policies of the Sheriff, the District Attorney, and the Board of Supervisors and has shown remarkable talent in doing so. His efficiency and dedication to the law enforcement profession has contributed greatly to the professionalism of the staff of the Napa County Sheriff's Department and the Napa County District Attorney's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that on the occasion of his retirement, the Board of Supervisors wishes to express its appreciation to Edward H. Wynn for his many years of effective and loyal service to the public; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors and the numerous associates and friends with whom Ed has worked over the years wish to acknowledge and thank him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Napa County and wish he and his wife Joyce happiness, good health and contentment in his retirement.
