All clients admitted to the SACPA program for the receipt of drug treatment and other services are responsible for the payment of fees based on their ability to pay. Napa County Health and Human Services assesses ability to pay by means of the "Uniform Method for Determining Ability to Pay (UMDAP), as promulgated by the California Department of Mental Health. Clients who are eligible for coverage under Drug/MediCal shall be responsible for the lesser of their Drug/MediCal "share of the cost" or their liability under UMDAP. The fees for the provision of services are as follows:
