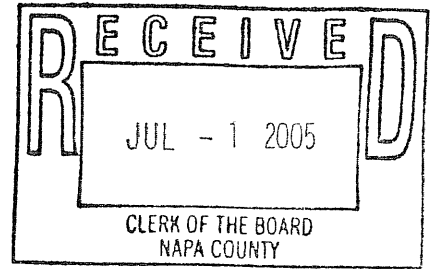

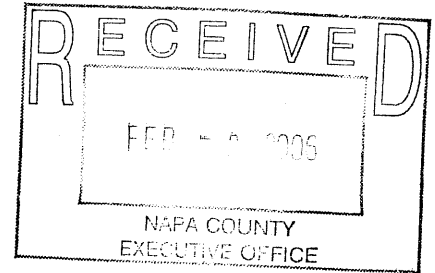

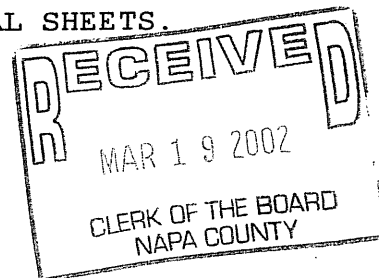

I can bring commitment and a strong belief in the value of the role of the Tobacco Advisory Board in the community. I understand the dangers of smoking because my father died of lung cancer from smoking. My sisters, brothers and I experienced the effects of second-hand smoke in our household. I would like to work toward preventing more deaths and illnesses from smoking.

I have been an educator for twenty-eight years. I can bring my years of experience in developing educational programs to the Tobacco Advisory Board. While it is important that an educational program reach all of the community, it is especially vital that children are educated and made aware of the dangers of smoking. Reaching the young before they start to smoke is essential. Awareness will help the young decide to not smoke. This in turn, will prevent illness and deaths.

I can bring an educator's point of view to the Board. I can work with the schools to promote the dangers of smoking and of second-hand smoke.

Last year I wrote a \$5,000 grant for a program to promote awareness of the dangers of second-hand smoke at Napa Valley Adult School. The grant was funded by the Tobacco Advisory Board. The implementation of this program illustrated the importance of awareness through education. Our adult students carried the non-smoking messages home to their families.

I would like to serve as a member of the Tobacco Advisory Board. I welcome an opportunity to serve my community and believe I can be constructive toward the Board's role in Napa County.

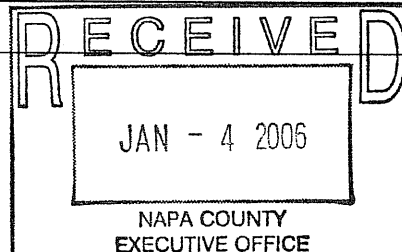
