

- "Relay" events






2016 Experiences

- 26 events
 - Higher than 2015 (24)
 - Lower than 2014 peak (27)
 - Few complaints


- Date reservations
- Application sequence
- Fee waivers
- Blackout dates

- Ordinance exemptions





Date Reservations

- Requests accepted 1st week of month for entire month the following year
- Sort out the frequency limitations
 - Assign dates
- Requests after that first come, first served




Application Sequence

- Current system
 - Date request up to 1 year
 - Fee deposit 6 months
 - Complete application 90 days



- Date request up to 1 year
- Complete application/fee 90 days






Fee waivers

- Current requirement
 - 501(c)3 organization
- Proposed requirement
 - Any 501(c) organization




 Cleaning deposit still required (refundable)




Blackout Dates

Complaint Process

- Complaint received
- Verify complaint
- Refer to applicant
- Probation 1 year
 - Pass probation
 - Repeat probation
 - Ban for 5 years





Ordinance Exemptions


- Bicycle events complying with CVC
 - Insurance requirements
 - "Hold Harmless" agreement
 - Notify Public Works






- Need to coordinate with other events
- Recommend delete exemption language
