

## Deputy Sector Navigator, Napa Valley College - Present

I represent key talent for the Economic and Workforce Development of the CCCCO in the North and East Bay Area, serving 6 counties and 14 colleges. Deputy Sector Navigators (DSN) serve as the information, communication and advisory roles for the colleges to provide information on labor market need and employer training requirements to help colleges develop more and better CTE. As DSN I play a key role in CTE Enhancement and Strong Workforce program development. By using labor market data analysis and developing key relationships in the industry/community I work to help make college offerings more responsive to the needs of employers and workers.

**Facilitator/Teaching Artist:** I created and deliver a community outreach program called "Conversations About Death". In the three week program we discuss typical ways of dying, costs and interventions available for common mortal illnesses, and legal and interpersonal actions to help identify and articulate end-of-life wishes. I have secured grants to deliver this program to the community, including through the Sacramento Metro Arts Commission.

- Community: Conversations About Death workshops engage communities, medical teams, families, spiritual homes, and individuals experiencing the profound change surrounding end-of-
- **Personal Reflection**: Conversations About Death uses art to explore practical end-of-life decision making in the context of personal values and aspirational legacy. Have been awarded Arts Council Grants for this Art and the Elderly Program.
- Facilitated Conversations: I work with families and care teams to facilitate these important conversations -- among family, friends, advocates; aging parents, adult children and chosen decision makers.
- Resource services during dying: I often serve as a ministry of presence and recommend and secure end-of-life resources for music, chanting, reading, praying, photography, massage -- all provided by people sensitive to the dying process.

#### Director, US SBA/LRCCD Business and Economic Development Center:

Supervised 13 direct reports; wrote grant applications; developed budgets; negotiated funding; leveraged community resources; developed program goals, media/PR/marketing plans and designed outreach programs. Work to provide business advising services to the self-employed/entrepreneur, artists, gig workers, independent consultants.
