RE: SUPPORTING APPEAL OF NAPA COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION ACTION APPROVING MOUNTAIN PEAK WINERY-USE PERMIT #P13-00320-UP

Dear Napa County Board of Supervisors,

My name is Steve Chilton and I own property on Soda Canyon Road, Napa, CA 94558. My wife and I constructed our home on a small acreage that has been in her family for nearly 100 years. While designing the house we worked around the 100+ year old oaks and Soda Creek. No oaks were removed for the house nor was the creek impacted. We practice positive environmental stewardship and expect the County and others on Soda Canyon Road to do the same. I recently retired from a career of 35 years with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and the US Fish and Wildlife Service. I strongly support the Appeal of the Napa County Planning Commission approval of the Mountain Peak project and request that you uphold the appeal.

The Planning Commission demonstrated an arbitrary decision making process when they considered the Mountain Peak Project and other projects such as the Flynnville Winery Project. The Flynnville Project was a smaller winery (60,000 gallons a year versus 100,000 gallons per year for the Mountain Peak winery), that was bordered on four sides by roads, including Highway 29 and was essentially a redevelopment that was opposed by several neighbors (I believe four neighbors testified in opposition to the project). Mountain Peak is larger, is six plus miles up a narrow, steep dead end road, will have numerous impacts upon the environment and is opposed by over 900 citizens. At the urging of the Planning Commission, the Flynnville applicants reduced the winery to 40,000 gallons per year and the Commission approved it.

What did those four opponents bring to the Commission that caused them to require this reduction in gallons per year that hundreds of opponents to Mountain Peak did not? Or was it merely a matter of clout or personal influence?

Additionally, the Commission abused their discretion when it found that the Mountain Peak Project will not have a significant effect upon the environment and adopted a Negative Declaration. The Board of Supervisors must reverse the decision of the Planning Commission and deny the project or remand it for further consideration.

The size, scope and lack of environmental documentation of the project dictates that an Environmental Impact Report following the requirements of CEQA is mandatory. A negative declaration for a project this large and with its concurrent impacts upon water quality and quantity, wildlife, traffic, public safety, noise and vegetation cannot be supported by the facts. The Initial Study Checklist includes the finding that the proposed project could not have a significant effect on the environment. Section IV. A) of the checklist shows that the project will have a less than significant effect (not a no impact determination) upon unnamed species. The Rector Creek Watershed contains yellow-legged frogs and California giant salamanders, both listed species of special concern, but the negative declaration checklist mentions neither. Either county staff did not conduct a thorough survey of the area or they relied on consultants hired by the project proponents who apparently limited their survey to present a report that supported their client and not the facts. Also the California Red-Legged Frog is a federally listed threatened species by the US Fish and Wildlife Service and populations have been identified in Wragg Creek near Capell Valley Road. Similar, if not higher quality habitat occurs in the Rector Creek watershed.

Did county staff conduct or request a survey of possible special concern or threatened populations within the watershed? What is the basis for the statement that the project will have a less than significant effect rather than no impact?

CEQA regulations require that counties acting as lead agencies circulate CEQA documents to all Responsible/Trustee Agencies for comment. The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDF&W) is one of those responsible agencies. Apparently the County did not follow that regulation prior to the Planning Commission approving the Mountain Peak Project. The CDF&W was not informed and therefore did not comment on the CEQA document. It is unknown what they would have commented or informed the County of and just maybe would have averted the need for this hearing and additional costs to the County and its citizens.

This apparent violation of CEQA regulations and state law on its own is reason enough for the Board of Supervisors to reverse the Planning Commission decision, require an EIR and rehear the entire project. Continuing to support this project without knowing the full impacts could open the county to challenges from wildlife advocates such as the Center for Biological Diversity and others.

Sense and sensibility. In collecting the over 900 signatures on the petition opposing the issuance of proposed use permit #P13-00320-UP, requested by Mountain Peak Winery, each and every person expressed their grave concerns for having a winery, especially with visitation, at the top of Soda Canyon Road.

Denying the permit, or at the least, imposing significant and meaningful restrictions, made sense to all.

What also made sense to all, was to have the manufacturing plant, the winery, in the industrial part of Napa County, and leaving the land as it is, for the growing of grapes.

The signatures were gathered all across Napa County and each of your Supervisorial districts are represented.

Positive sum: The basic concerns of all of us in Napa County are: environment, water, fire, air, traffic, and the preservation of agriculture.

By allowing this permit for a winery, with caves, with visitation, all of the above are gravely impacted.

15,000+/- visitors a year, even with 2 persons in a car, still means that one trip up and one trip down the steep, winding, 6+ miles of canyon road, which gives basically 15,000+/- trips. With alcohol now part of the equation.

And, add trips for food service, maintenance, personnel, and about 3 years for the build-out, which means untold amounts of truck trips with large equipment, and materials needed for the project. The applicants own estimate of *yearly* trips the project will generate, is approximately 44,275.

By allowing Positive sum, leaving the land to continue to grow grapes, gives the best possible outcome.

The property, located at 3265 Soda Canyon road does not have the acreage required for a 100,000 gallon winery. They will be relying on grapes that are outsourced. The hope expressed is that grapes will be available at the top, there are no guarantees, as the properties are not owned or contiguous, thus there are no guarantees that grapes will be available. Thus, grapes might have to be brought up, and bottles down, more trips.

Again, a vote for having the actual manufacturing plant, winery, in the industrial part of Napa County, where grapes and the resources needed, could be easily acquired, and the land left to continue to grow grapes.

Dear Chair Ramos and the other Members of the Board:

I am writing to express my puzzlement and concerns over the Planning Commission's approval of this project. My puzzlement stems from the fact that, while they were quoted as acknowledging residents' concerns about dangerous driving conditions (i.e., the narrow, steep, winding, curves and blind drives and the fact that, in case of fire or other emergency on Soda Canyon Road and its arteries, there is only one access point), three of the four commissioners dismissed or rationalized the issues to find favor with the project. The risks surrounding this issue are only superficially due to or resolved by repairing pot holes (nice as that would be) and <u>any</u> increase in passenger, construction or agriculture equipment will only worsen the dangers and thereby increase the risk of harm to residents and existing tenants.

While I have many other serious concerns, including ones related to the degradation of the flora, fauna and geology of the environment proximate to proposed project, they also involve the larger watershed and the water supply to Yountville and the Veteran's Home. The details of the many problems with this project and reasons for its denial are systematically and well documented in the Appellant's Appeal Packet Form and the many other documents referenced therein and need not be repeated here.

I think your decision is not a matter of holding anyone hostage to existing conditions, as suggested in Commissioner Scott's comment. Rather, it is, "Does approval of the paroject increase the risk of harm to residents and the environment?" Once one studies and understands the data presented by the Appellants, Commissioner Cottrell's "No" vote is the one that protects the environment and does not increase the risk of harm to residents. I urge you to reverse the Planning Commission's approval of this project.

Dear Chair Ramos and Members of the Board of Supervisors:

On May 23, 2017 the appeal of the Planning Commission's action approving the Mountain Peak Winery will appear before the Board of Supervisors. The four appellants represent the more than 900 individuals who have signed the petition against the Mountain Peak Winery project. The appellants have provided factual evidence the Planning Commission decision is inconsistent with the Winery Definition Ordinance and the Napa County General Plan. Additionally the appellants cite numerous environmental factors the Planning Commission did not appropriately address. Although there are only four appellants in this matter, the outcome of this hearing will impact the entire county and is a turning point in the future direction of Napa County.

As a citizen who has attended many of then Mountain Peak Winery hearings and read subsequent related documentation, I would like to bring to the attention of the Board several specific issues I consider pertinent to this matter.

The criticism that continuances and this appeal have cost Mountain Peak Winery time and expense is without merit.

If the project was suitably sized to the property and area, the continuances and this appeal would probably not be necessary. Instead Mountain Peak Winery made a decision to maximize their impact on the land without regard to the agricultural character of the area and the surrounding community. It is common knowledge developers and their consultants present a grossly over stated project and when confronted with opposition, agree to reduce the project to significantly from the initial proposal. This is a tactic that has been used by developers and consultants before and the Napa County Planning Department and the Planning Commission should not be fooled into believing the downsizing of a project is a goodwill effort on the part of the developer to compromise. The lengthy process and expense to the developer (and county resources) is a direct result of their misguided belief that a project of this magnitude would go unnoticed and unchallenged.

The Planning Department's review of the project and their Negative Declaration is inadequate and their conclusion cannot be supported by the facts.

The check list used by the county to justify a Negative Declaration lacks depth and scientific rigor. How they could reach this decision considering the size of the overall project (103,016 sq ft), the substantial cave excavation (796,446 cubic feet of spoils), and the impacts on biological resources, is hard to believe. The size and scope of this project dictates an

Environmental Impact Report and the Negative Declaration is premature. This is a serious project, with far-reaching implications. To avoid the perception all winery projects are "rubber stamped" by the Planning Department and the Planning Commission, it is imperative the Board take a second look at this project, provide transparency for the Napa citizens and demand an in-depth scientific analysis.

It is in the best interest of the county to revisit this project now rather than face potential litigation on the doubtful merits on this project.

An in-depth scientific review of this project will address numerous issues that have the potential for future legal problems for the county. The run-off siltation into the Rector Dam Reservoir is a great concern since it is the drinking water source for the residents and visitors of Yountville and the California Veterans Home. The Rector Creek Watershed contains listed species of special concern, the Yellow-Legged Frogs and California Giant Salamanders. The project could impact the California Red-Legged Frog, which is a federally listed threatened species. I have Googled "frogs and lizard endangerment lawsuits in California" and got 3,130,000 hits. There are organizations and individuals who are willing to litigate to protect the biological and natural resources of California and instead of reacting, the county needs to be proactive and address these issues at this stage of the project. As a Napa County taxpayer, I would rather see my elected officials and the financial resources of this county address more pressing issues than fighting lawsuits. An environmental impact report would provide further analysis into these environmental issues and will limit additional costs and exposure to the county. It will provide valuable information to base a future thoughtful decision upon, while protecting the biological resources, watershed, and natural resources of our county, in addition to providing protection and reducing potential legal liability to the county.

Fire danger is and continues to be a major issue in Soda Canyon.

At the January 4, 2017 Planning Commission hearing, I presented information to the Planning Commission regarding the July 26, 2016 fire on Soda Canyon Road that was 200 feet from my home. According to the Wildland Fire Investigation report, it was concluded the fire was started by either arson or vehicle, possibly a vehicle towing a chain. In an subsequent article appearing in the Napa Register, it was reported, "County fire and road officials concluded that additional Soda Canyon Road traffic would not significantly increase the fire danger. A large proportion of the rural roads in Napa County are in hillside settings with high fire hazard, and many of these roads carry much larger volumes in daily traffic, including visitor traffic, without the vehicles causing significant threat of wild land fire," a county report said." I can disagree with this based on just common sense- more traffic equals more opportunity for vehicle accidents and would increase the risk of a fire caused by a tossed cigarette butt or a trailer with a chain dragging on the pavement.

Recently I have obtained a number of fire incident reports from Cal Fire and these reports are exclusively of the Soda Canyon area and are from selected years from 2004-2016. These reports, a summary of which is also attached to this letter, demonstrate an increase of incidents during traditional heavy winery visitation periods (such as tasting and events during harvest season) and seasonal vineyard maintenance. Although lengthy and numerous, the attached documentation is worthy of your serious review and consideration. We who live Soda Canyon, consider this an extremely serious issue.

The four appellants are joined by over 900 individuals who are similarly concerned with the substantial impacts the Mountain Peak Project will have on the rural character of Napa County. Prior to making your final decision, I urge the board to remember the governing documents, the WDO, the General Plan, and the concerns of the Napa citizens they represent.

I witnessed a major tanker

transport truck stall about 8:15-8:30am, April 19, 2017, at the steepest portion of Soda Canyon where the grade is 11%. The stalled truck attempted numerous times for almost an hour, to make the grade but kept slipping. The road was too steep and icy that morning. Eventually two large trucks had to be called to pull the transport truck up the final grade to its destination.

The stalled truck caused a major blockage of the roadway and consequent back-up of residents, vineyard workers and others who could not get around the truck in either direction.

After waiting 10 minutes and witnessing the skidding backward, convulsing truck I decided to capture it on my phone. Attached please find several short videos of the incident.

This was an industrial truck bound for a commercial business at the top of Soda Canyon. I bring this up as regards the proposed Mountain Peak Winery because of the particular access problems to the MPW site. Big rigs and double loaders heavily loaded regularly stall and cannot make the grade on Soda Canyon Road and specifically at the site in the videos.

MPW will add ~40,000 vehicles, many of which will be large commercial vehicles to the road; this presents serious public safety issues.

I therefore ask the Board of Supervisors to deny the MPW application. Short of that to please significantly reduce the winery size, production levels and public tours/events allowed in the permit and thereby reduce the number of large trucks on our dead-end road.

If there had been an emergency [and Soda Canyon Road has the second highest number of emergency incidents/accidents of all roads in Napa County] no vehicles could have gotten around this truck.

Please protect our fragile environment and the safety of our homes from unwarranted, industrial strength mega-event centers in remote location in Napa County. If anything the MPW project belongs on the Valley floor.

I am a resident of Soda Canyon Road, and write concerning the Mountain Peak appeal. I have reviewed the KC Engineering Report and the Crane Transportation Group and Bartlett Engineering reports on the condition of Soda Canyon Road. In my opinion, this road in its current layout and condition is unacceptably hazardous for permitting of industrial winery traffic and tourist traffic beyond current levels. Bringing the road up to the county's current road standards for access to wineries and other industries would have a very large environmental impact on this remote area, and a very large impact on the county's road budget. On the other hand, failing to require that the road be brought up to these standards would be recklessly negligent, exposing the county and its taxpayers to major litigation costs, and exposing individual supervisors to liability for negligence in dutiful consideration of actions affecting its taxpayers.

I am an emeritus Professor of Economics at the University of California, Berkeley, and a principal in the Brattle Group, a firm specializing in litigation support. I was previously a principal in Cambridge Systematics, a transportation and traffic engineering firm. I received a Nobel Prize in 2000 for my studies of demand for transportation, and I have published extensively on transportation matters.
