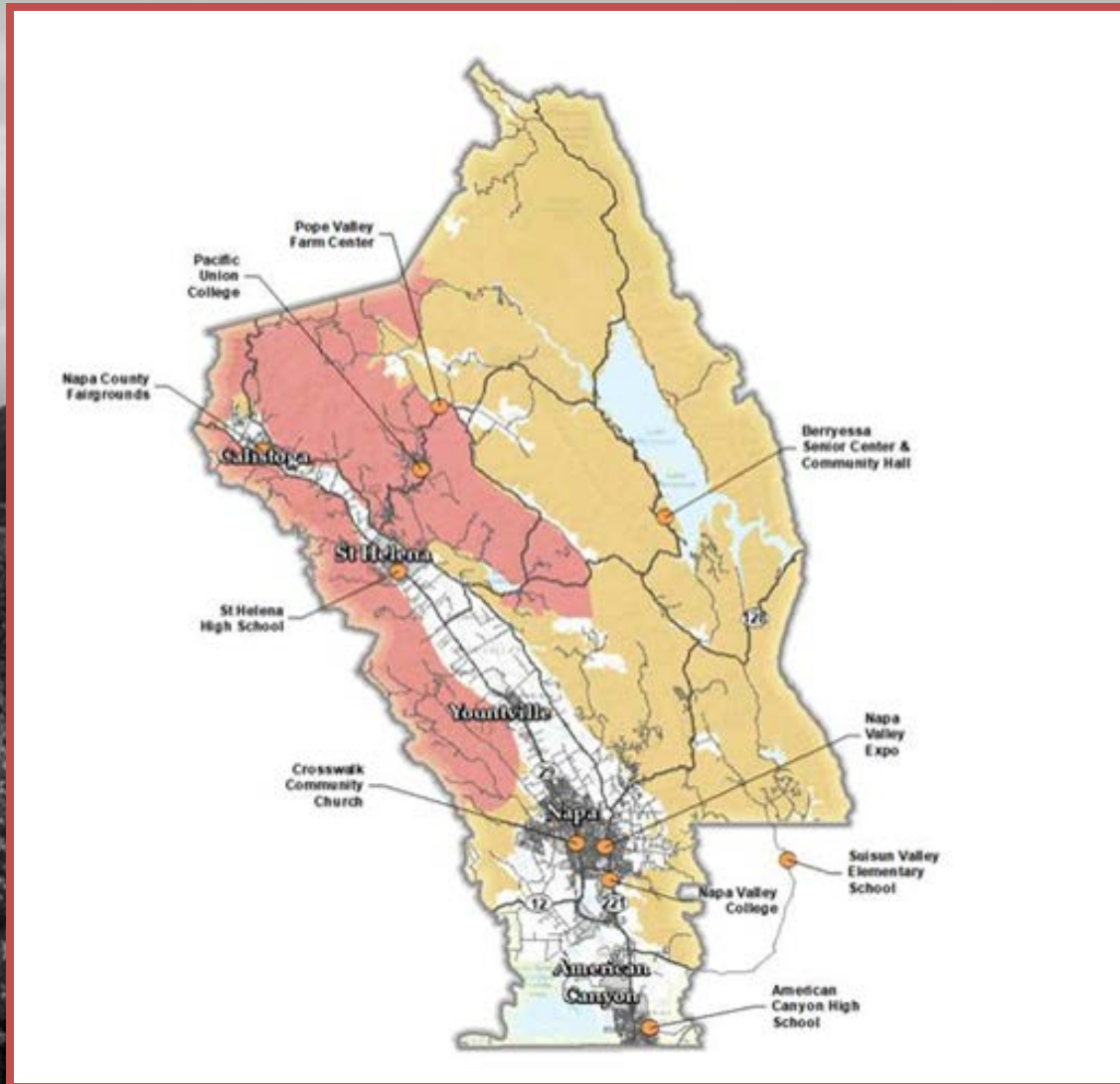

How will I know if a **PSPS** has been called in my neighborhood?

Because extreme weather threats can change quickly, our goal is to provide notice through phone calls, emails and text messages to customers 48 hours in advance, again at 24 hours and again just prior to turning off the power for safety. Updates will also be shared through social media, local news, radio and pge.com until the time power is restored. To receive important outage alerts, update your contact information at pge.com/mywildfirealerts.

How can I prepare for a **PSPS**?

We advise you to think in advance about your family's needs and how you might be impacted in the event of a power shutoff — or for any emergency.

- Do you have a personal safety plan for all members of your family, including pets?
- If you own a generator, is it ready to operate safely?
- Do you know how to open your garage door manually?
- Do you have cash and a full tank of gas, in the event ATMs and gas stations are unavailable?
- Are your mobile phones fully charged?
