List of potential projects to complete in the 2020-2024 time period:

- 1. 2020
  - a. Install asphalt pads for two RV sites for ADA compliance
  - b. ADA access to bathroom 7&8
  - c. Install two additional ADA-compliant full-hook-up RV campsites
  - d. Remodel social hall
  - e. New porcelain floor for bathroom 7
- 2. 2021
  - a. Develop additional novice-friendly trails within park
  - b. Install upgraded LED lighting in RV park
  - c. Potential solar power for entire park
  - d. Revamp pathways in CNPS native plants garden
- 3. 2022
  - a. Upgrade electric lines in "picnic partials" RV camping area
  - b. Install bike wash station by parking lot
  - c. Pave entry road to barn
- 4. 2023
  - a. Repair asphalt entry to park
  - b. Update gate entry for park
  - c. Removal of 30+ stumps in lower acres of park
- 5. 2024
  - a. Designate and install additional pinicnicking sites within "lower 50" area
  - b. Install family recreation area on the west side of social hall
  - c. Enlarge dog run area with picnic bench under oak tree

Prior projects completed during the 2015-2019 time period:

- 6. 2015
  - a. Moved water lines in picnic partials for individual hook ups
  - b. Removed and cleared invasive plants from CNPS for garden area
  - c. Created water valve map for entire park
- 7. 2016
  - a. Leveled ground on the west side of the social hall
  - b. Remodeled showers 5&6
  - c. Weather sealed social hall decking
- 8. 2017
  - a. Replaced park truck
  - b. Installed split rail fencing in tent camping area
  - c. Installed split rail fencing around parking lot
- 9. 2018
  - a. Epoxy sealed bathroom floor 1&2
  - b. Installed porcelain tile floor for bathroom 8
  - c. Cut trail tread on manzanita entrance for water drainage

## 10. 2019

- a. Installed fiber optic line for park internet service
- b. Filled woodpecker holes and painted exterior of social hall
- c. Leveled picnic partials RV area for year round camping.
- d. Launched new park website including web-based reservation system for campsites, online purchase of day and annual passes
- e. Installed electronic payment kiosk on River-to-Ridge trail
