Biographical Sketch of Mr. Lee C. Broad

Following an international lending post at The Bank of New York, Mr. Broad began his business and financial advisory career with A. T. Kearney, Inc. and was a Principal of that firm in New York. At Kearney, he was responsible for business development and management of client engagements within the firm's Corporate and Marketing Strategy practice.

Mr. Broad left Kearney to accept the position of Vice President-Corporate Development at E. F. Hutton & Company, Inc., where he managed a group of analysts and consulting professionals that examined strategic and operational issues, primarily for the President of the firm and his direct reports. At Hutton, he met Mr. Paul G. Hines, his direct supervisor, and formed a personal and professional friendship that, later, resulted in the formation of Starting Point Associates.

Mr. Broad then joined Kidder, Peabody & Co., Incorporated reporting directly to the firm's President and COO. At Kidder, after two year's of conducting special assignments for the President and Management Committee, he was elected partner and promoted to Director-Individual Sales Marketing supporting the firm's 1,750 retail brokers in 68 branches.

In the years following his work on Wall Street, Mr. Broad returned to consulting and in 1989, formed Chandler Broad Associates, Inc., which is the predecessor of Starting Point Associates. In addition to working with clients on specific project-oriented engagements, he has served in short-term executive capacities as Strategic Planning Executive of United Research, Vice President-Operations of Children's Wonderland, Inc. and President of Dynamic Sciences, Inc.

Mr. Broad has long been active in community and non-profit organizations, including churches, Habitat for Humanity, The Society for the Right to Die, the Boy Scouts of America, the Securities Industry Association Firm and Industry Analysis Committee, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, and Columbia University. He is a certified Stephen Minister. At present within the Napa community, he is a member of the Napa Sunrise Rotary Club. He serves as the Treasurer of the First Presbyterian Church and is a member of the church's Finance Committee, Investment Committee, Building Fund Committee, and Choir. He also serves on the Board of Directors of the Presbyterian Day School and the If Given a Chance Foundation. Mr. Broad is a member of The Land Trust of Napa County and a working member of the Land Trust's Monitoring Committee, which oversees nearly 50,000 acres of land owned by the Trust or subject to an environmental easement agreement.

Mr. Broad authored seven articles published in the *Lipper Securities Industry Financial Analysis Service*. He has also written "Matrix Organizations: Can They Work?;" "Navigating Class Action Settlements;" "Expense Management in Branch Organizations;" "Managing Outside Counsel With Success;" "Managing Imperfection;" "Technology or Mythology?;" "Project Management: It's What's Up Front That Counts;" and "High-Impact Organizations: Why and How They Work."

To Whom It May Concern:

I am interested in serving on the Napa County Children and Families Commission. My focus for the last five years has been creating integrated support services for the children of Calistoga. I am convinced that children are better learners when fundamental health, nutrition and psychological needs are met within the family, in pre-school programs, and by a supportive, active community.

To that end I have been instrumental in creating The Family Center, a family resource center housed at Calistoga Elementary School. I have served as the Chair of the Steering Committee and in the last year founded a non-profit 501(c){3}, Calistoga Friends of The Family Center, to insure the long-term sustainability of the program.

Until The Family Center was established, funded by a Healthy Start grant that expires in 2004, there were no county services available in Calistoga. Many kindergarteners were not immunized at the opening of school, had no previous experience in learning or socialization, and were not having basic needs met at home. It is imperative, given the socio-economics of Calistoga and the UpValley region of the county, that services be available and an integrated part of our culture, that there be fair and equitable distribution of state and county dollars throughout the county. I would like to represent UpValley children and support programs on the Children and Families Commission. I am aware of the needs, existing programs and funding shortfalls that might be supported by the Prop. 10 dollars.

I am willing to contribute the required time at monthly meetings, as well as serve on working committees. My strengths lie in grant proposal review and program development. I have experience in public education and outreach that may serve the commission positively. I am comfortable with public speaking and team building to maximize efficiency and accountability.

Family resource centers are an effective means of meeting the needs of children 0-5, educating families, and providing support services in a cost efficient manner. Integrating parent education, mental and physical health services, nurturing social and emotional development of children and families can only increase school readiness and success in school. I am convinced that the support of existing programs and creation of new community programs based on need, will enhance the cultural, economic and intellectual state of our county.
