To Whom It May Concern:



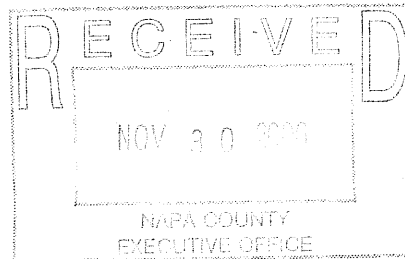
I am looking forward to hearing more about the available position on the Conservation Commission. I will contact the Executive office in a week or so to make sure that my application was successfully received.
