

### Occupational Experience:

Presently with Solano County as the PARKS SERVICE MANAGER. Responsible for the regional park system and supervising a staff which includes Park Rangers and extra help forces. There is estimated a total of \$4,581,552 in a five year budget for parks capital improvements. The Parks & Recreation element of the General Plan was recently updated (last revised in 1983). As a result of this element update, a leadership role has been assumed to coordinate regional recreation activities in cooperation with other agencies and parks interest groups. Support is provided to the County Parks & Recreation Commission, who also distributes Fish & Wildlife fee funds to non-profit organizations or projects annually. Employed since Spring 2002.

Previously with the City of Richmond as the PARKS AND LANDSCAPING SUPERINTENDENT, supervising a staff of 29 full time and 6 part time employees servicing 385 acres of parks and other public spaces and overseeing contractors servicing 136 acres in the a Landscape District and special Service Areas. Work was also directed by agreements with the California Conservation Corps and Contra Costa County Court Referrals. 29,460 city trees were serviced citywide. Created a contract to service 469 acres of High Fire Hazard Severity Zones. Review was made of 52 acres of future parks in various stages of construction and planning. Over \$4,133,000 in combined annual operations budgets were applied as well as a wide array of capital improvement budgets (estimated for five years at over \$14,000,000). Activities were coordinated with Recreation, Engineering, Planning, Redevelopment, and 30 Neighborhood Councils. Support was provided to the Recreation and Parks Commission and the Urban Forest Advisory Committee. Employed from Fall 1996 to Spring 2002.

Previously with the City of Vallejo, as a LANDSCAPE INSPECTOR, where landscape plans were reviewed for City acceptance and were coordinated with grading, erosion control, public improvement and specific area plans of subdivision, commercial, mitigation and capital improvement projects. Preparations were made for engineer's reports, contracts and budgets (totaling \$1,500,000 +) for 24 landscape maintenance and lighting districts (totaling 1,600 + acres). Provided designs for City landscapes. Wrote the landscape and fencing sections for the "City of Vallejo Regulations and Specifications for Public Improvements" as well as several supporting guidelines having to do with erosion control, water conservation and other related endeavors. Provided engineer's estimates for bonding, construction and budgeting purposes. Field inspections were made of numerous projects in a rapidly growing community. Employed from Spring 1988 to Fall 1996.

Previously with Golden California Landscape as **GENERAL MANAGER**, supervising a staff of 25 employees while providing job site surveys, supervision, estimations, customer consultation and pest control management, as well as contract and budget administration. # Napa County Parks and Open Space Advisory Committee Ron Taddei July 14, 2004

I will bring my previous work experience, as well as my educational background, and current vineyard ownership experience to the Committee.

I retired from land use planning after spending more than two decades working for Sonoma County. Some of the projects and functions I performed during that time included:

- Writing a "specific land use plan" for 16,000 acres of unincorporated territory west of Santa Rosa. That plan, adopted by the Board of Supervisors, provided land use protection for: a portion of what has now become the Russian River Viticultural Area; an ecologically unique lagoon; large tracts of dairy lands, where reclaimed wastewater was used for irrigation; the crossroads village of Fulton, through physical design guidelines.
- Serving as chairman of the Sonoma County Design Review Committee which reviewed all variety of urban multi family residential, commercial, and industrial development, as well as community and regional parks.
- ➡ Writing the 1990-95 Housing Element for the Sonoma County General Plan, adopted by the Board of Supervisors, which included programs resulting in the development of housing affordable to Lower and Moderate Income Households.
- Serving as staff to the Sonoma County Airport Land Use Commission, at a time when the commission was developing Comprehensive Land Use Plans (land use regulations) for the Sonoma County Airport, three municipal airports, and two privately owned, public use airports.
- ➡ Writing design guidelines for hillside development on Sonoma Mountain a 45,000-acre formation which separates the Sonoma and the Santa Rosa-Petaluma valleys, and which is highly visible from Route 12 (a state-designated Scenic Highway) and U.S. 101 Highway which were adopted by the Board of Supervisors.
