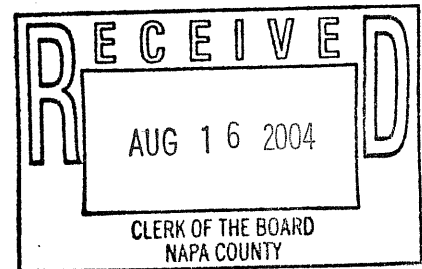

#### AMENDING CHAPTER 2.04 REGARDING THE DATE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The City Council of the City of St. Helena does ordain as follows:

Section 2.04.010 is amended as follows:

#### 2.04.010 Municipal elections

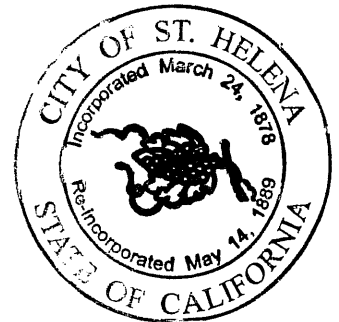
Beginning with elections held after March 2005 the general municipal election for the City Council shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year beginning November 2006.


