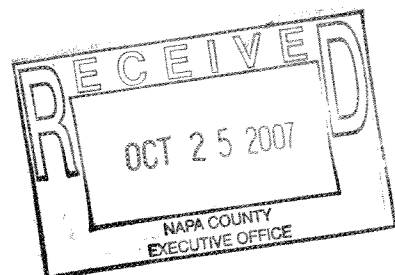

Section IV – Commissioner Emeritus

Upon approval by the Board of Supervisors, the Commissioner Emeritus shall become a non-voting member of the Napa County Commission on Aging for an indefinite term.
