ROAD CLOSURES ON MARCH 2ND

Dear Resident:

The good news is that you will have a front row seat for the greatest sporting event held in this area, The 30th annual Kaiser Permanente Napa Valley Marathon.

The bad news is that for the safety of the runners it will be necessary to close down sections of Silverado Trail, Oak Knoll Ave., Big Ranch Road and El Centro Ave. for a period of time. The following times are only approximate but should give you guidelines to minimize any disruption of your day.

Silverado Trail from Calistoga to Dunaweal Lane5:30 AM to 8:00 AM
Silverado Trail from Dunaweal Lane to Deer Park6:00 AM to 9:00 AM
Silverado Trail from Deer Park to Highway 1287:00 AM to 10:00 AM
Silverado Trail from Highway 128 to Yountville Crossroads8:00 AM to 11:00 AM
Silverado Trail from Yountville Crossroads to Oak Knoll Ave8:15 AM to 11:45 AM
Oak Knoll Ave. to Vintage Highschool9:00 AM to 12:30 PM

Those residents north of 128 Silverado Trail that have to leave while the Silverado Trail is closed will have to go southbound at the speed of the runners and leave Silverado trail at the closest intersection.

South of 128 the northbound lane of Silverado Trail will be open for residents and workers only. If you must leave go northbound to the nearest intersection and exit Silverado Trail.

The runners will follow Silverado Trail for 23 miles, down to Oak Knoll Ave. The balance of the 26.1 miles will take them to the finish at Vintage Highschool.

Come on out and enjoy the race. The following are the approximate times the runners will reach various intersections:
