



Resume Of

Donald R. Peterson

For 32 years I worked professionally in the field of Economics. During those years I was employed by the Federal Government's, Bureau of Labor Statistic (BLS). The Bureau is one of the Federal Government's premier producer's of economic data. Some of its better known economic data series are: the Consumers Price Index, the Employment & Unemployment data series, the Producers Price Index, the Productivity Index, and the International Price Index.

I began my career as a junior economist collecting and analyzing industrial relations data, and from there went on to work on several others statistical programs operated exclusively by the Bureau. Later, additional experience was gained by working on, and managing several of the Bureau's Federal/State cooperative statistical programs. On this last point a bit of explanation will be helpful.

While the BLS solely administers many economical and statistical programs, it has proved profitable to operate other economic programs in cooperation with the various states. The reason for this approach is that most states share a common desire with the Federal Government to have at their access, select economic data for them to administer economic policies within their states' jurisdictions. For example, for administering fiscal policy, the Federal Reserve has a vital interest in knowing what the most recent consumer price index is showing in terms of inflationary pressure, while also considering its relationship to the most recent national unemployment rate. The states are also keenly interested in knowing what their particular state unemployment rate is measuring.

Because of the shared interest of both, for many years the states have operated many economic programs in a cooperative fashion with the Federal Government (BLS) taking an oversight position. The states collect data from employers and state agencies (employment offices) while the Bureau defines and monitors the methodology used in compiling state statistical indexes from those data. Those state data are then "rolled-up" by a carefully prescribed methodology to economic data representing the whole United States.

For years I administered those programs for the 8-Western States. In so doing I met and dealt with many high-level state officials. I was responsible for contract negotiations involving millions of dollars. During the latter part of my Federal Government service, I served as the Regional Economist for the San Francisco Regional office, 1 of 8 Regional Offices, and the largest. I believe my years of analytical background, together with my policy, administrative and management experience would mesh well with the functions called upon by the requirements of Public Member, Napa Sanitation District Board of Directors.
