WHEREAS, Bill began his long and distinguished career in law enforcement when he attended Napa Valley College and joined the campus police; and

WHEREAS, Bill joined the Calistoga Police Department as a patrolman in August, 1973 spending some time as a police dispatcher in that Department, which lasted until he went to work as a patrolman for the Suisun Police Department in 1977; and

WHEREAS, Bill joined the Napa County Sheriff's Department as a deputy sheriff, under Sheriff Earl Randol in December, 1977, and distinguished himself over the next eighteen years as a patrol deputy, narcotics investigator, and homicide investigator; and

WHEREAS, Bill was hired as an investigator with the Napa County District Attorney's Office by District Attorney Anthony Perez in 1995; was promoted to supervising investigator by District Attorney Gary Lieberstein in 2004; and was promoted to Chief Investigator by District Attorney Gary Lieberstein in 2005, having distinguished himself in the fields of domestic violence and homicide investigations; and

WHEREAS, Bill is known among his friends and co-workers for his patriotism, his integrity, his loyalty and his dedication to truth, justice, and doing the right thing; and

WHEREAS, at the time of his retirement Bill has served the victim's of crime in Napa County and the State of California for thirty-five years with distinction and perseverance to insure that they receive justice.
