*WHEREAS*, every child in our great Napa County is a precious gift, full of promise and potential; and


*WHEREAS*, child abuse and neglect is a serious problem in California and across the nation; and


*WHEREAS*, children are our most precious resource and we are committed to keeping the children of Napa County safe and happy.
