#### 4. SAFETY MOMENT - Protect Yourself from Wildfire Smoke

Dry conditions and erratic weather in California have resulted in a large number of wildfire. Stay alert for wildfire smoke! This smoke can hurt your eyes, irritate your respiratory system, and worsen chronic heart and lung diseases. Monitor local air quality and listen for news or health warnings about smoke. You can monitor your community via U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Air Quality Index (AQI) or check the report for your area at AirNow.gov. If you are advised to stay indoors keep windows and doors closed, run an air conditioner, but keep the fresh-air intake closed and the filter clean to prevent outdoor smoke from getting inside. If you must go outdoors, wear a respirator mask with an N95 rating, and avoid any strenuous activities.
