4. SAFETY MOMENT - Safe Wet Weather Driving

The rain in Spain may stay mainly on the plain, but here in the States there's an awful lot of it on the roadway. Rain is blamed for thousands of accidents yearly. Many of these accidents are preventable, but are caused by intrepid drivers who don't realize that fair- and foul-weather driving are fundamentally different. Here are a few tips to help you arrive safely:

- First and foremost: slow down, it takes longer to stop or adjust in wet weather.
- Maintain proper following distance (3 Second Rule). This needs to be increased in wet weather.
- Avoid using your brakes; if possible, take your foot off the accelerator to slow down.

• Turn your headlights on even in a light rain, or in gloomy, foggy or overcast conditions. Not only do they help you see the road, but they'll help other drivers see you.
